Recorrido de contenidos – Primer trimestre:

The Youth of today-Having Fun-Tell me a Story-Let's Celebrate

Topic vocabulary and topic phrasal verbs on daily life. Present simple and present continuous. Frequency adverbs. Listening for gist and for specific information.

Topic vocabulary: Hobbies and leisure. Word formation. Past simple (regular and irregular forms). Speaking: Expressing preferences. Writing: Informal e-mail.

. Topic vocabulary. Word analysis. Past simple and past continuous. Prepositions. Imperative form. Infinitives and –ing forms. Writing: story. Speaking: favourite story.

Topic vocabulary. Present perfect simple (*already/ yet/ just/ ever/ never*). Adjectives. Speaking: planning a party. Making offers and suggestions. Writing: note to a friend

***Recorrido de contenidos – Segundo trimestre:
Off we Go!- Doing it Right - Make it?Build it!- Weird World***

Topic vocabulary: holidays. Compound nouns. The future: *will & be going to*. gist/for
Speaking: future holidays (talking about future plans and intentions). Writing: postcard.

Topic vocabulary: school. Word patterns. Speaking: expressing obligation; lack of
obligation; giving advice. Modal verbs. Writing: letter of advice to a friend.

Topic vocabulary: technology. Compound nouns. The passive. Use of *by*. Speaking:
expressing agreement, disagreement, contradiction.

Topic vocabulary: the natural world. Word formation. Articles. Countable and
uncountable nouns. Writing: description of a place. Speaking: Expressing degrees of
certainty and doubt.

Want Anymore?- All Sorts of People!-Looking Good!- It's a Goal!-Right Time,
Right Place!***

Topic vocabulary: food and drink. Prepositions. Countable and uncountable nouns. (*lots
of, (not) many/much, a Little, a few*). Clauses and connectives.

Topic vocabulary: describing people and appearance. Word formation. Articles.
Adjectives and adverbs. Writing: Description of a person. Speaking: Describing people.

Topic vocabulary: fashion and clothes. Phrasal verbs. Listening for gist and for specific
information. Speaking: talking about clothes and paying compliments. Comparatives
and superlatives.

Topic vocabulary: sport. Collocations. Listening for gist and for specific information .
Zero, first and second conditional. Writing: description of a sport. Speaking: identifying
and describing objects.

Topic vocabulary: times and dates. Collocations. Listening for gist and for specific
information. Present perfect simple (*for/since*), prepositions of time and place.
Speaking: meeting people, making and responding to offers/suggestions. Writing:
informal email.
